11 Types of Persons Permitted to Enter Thailand

- 1  Thai nationals
- 2  Persons with exemption or persons being considered, permitted or invited by the Prime Minister
- 3  Persons on diplomatic or consular missions
- 4  Carriers of necessary goods
- 5  Crew members
- 6  Non-Thai nationals who are a spouse, parents, or children of a Thai national
- 7  Non-Thai nationals who hold a valid certificate of permanent residency
- 8  Non-Thai nationals who are permitted to work and their family members
- 9  Non-Thai nationals who are students of educational institutions approved by Thai authorities and their family members
- 10  Non-Thai nationals who are in need of medical treatment in Thailand and accompanying persons

11 Non-Thai nationals who have been granted permission to enter into the Kingdom

***Required documents for all travellers to enter Thailand**

- Certificate of Entry (COE) into Thailand
- "Fit to Fly" Health Certificate issued within 72 hours before departure
- A medical certificate showing Covid-19 negative, within 72 hours before departure
- A copy of Health Insurance with at least USD 100,000 medical expense coverage for COVID-19
